## 31 DAYS of 4<sup>TH</sup> WATCH SCRIPTURES

### **DAY 1 TOPIC: PRAYER**

**1 Thessalonians 5:17** (NKJV) - "pray without ceasing"

**James 5:16** (NKJV) - "Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, <sup>[b]</sup>fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."

**Philippians 4:6** (NKJV) - "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God."

**Mark 1:35** (NKJV) - "Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed."

### **DAY 2 TOPIC: FAITH**

**2 Corinthians 5:7** (NKJV) - "For we walk by faith, not by sight."

**Hebrews 11:1** (NKJV) - "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

**Hebrews 11:6** (NKJV) - "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

### **DAY 3 TOPIC: JOY**

**Nehemiah 8:10** (NKJV) - "Then he said to them, “Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.”

**Psalm 16:11** (NKJV) - "You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

**Philippians 4:4** (NKJV) - "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!"

### **DAY 4 TOPIC: PEACE**

**John 16:33** (NKJV) - "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

**Isaiah 26:3** (NKJV) - "You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You."

**Matthew 5:9** (NKJV) - "Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God."

### **DAY 5 TOPIC: LOVE**

**John 15:13** (NKJV) - "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends."

**John 3:16** (NKJV) - "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

**Deuteronomy 6:5** (NKJV) - "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength."

**Psalm 91:4** (NKJV) - "He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler."

### **DAY 6 TOPIC: FORGIVENESS**

**Matt 6:14** (NKJV) - "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you."

**2 Chronicles 7:14** (NKJV) - "If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

**Luke 6:37** (NKJV) - "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven."

**Psalm 86:5** (NKJV) - "For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in mercy to all those who call upon You."

### **DAY 7 TOPIC: COMPASSION**

**Mark 6:34** (NKJV) - "And Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to teach them many things."

**2 Corinthians 1:3-4** (NKJV) - "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God."

**Matthew 14:14** (NKJV) - "And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick."

### **DAY 8 TOPIC: VICTORY**

**1 Corinthians 15:57** (NKJV) - "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

**Psalm 44:3** (NKJV) - "For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, Nor did their own arm save them; But it was Your right hand, Your arm, and the light of Your countenance, Because You favored them."

**1 John 5:4** (NKJV) - "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world our faith."

### **DAY 9 TOPIC: TITHE**

**Malachi 3:10** (NKJV) - "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it."

**Luke 18:12** (NKJV) - "I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess."

**Leviticus 27:30** (NKJV) - "And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's. It is holy to the Lord."

## **DAY 10 TOPIC: PARENTING**

***Proverbs 22:6*** (NKJV) - "Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it."

***Ephesians 6:4*** (NKJV) - "And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord."

***2 Corinthians 12:14*** (NKJV) - "Now for the third time I am ready to come to you. And I will not be burdensome to you; for I do not seek yours, but you. For the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children."

## **Day 11 TOPIC: CHILDREN**

***Ephesians 6:1-4*** (NKJV) - "Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth." And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord."

***Proverbs 29:15*** (NKJV) - "The rod and rebuke give wisdom, But a child left to himself brings shame to his mother."

***Exodus 20:12*** (NKJV) - "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the Lord your God is giving you."

***Leviticus 19:31*** (NKJV) - "Stand up in the presence of the aged, show respect for the elderly and revere your God. I am the Lord."

## **DAY 12 TOPIC: FEAR**

***Isaiah 41:10*** (NKJV) - "Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand."

***2 Timothy 1:7*** (NKJV) - "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

***Isaiah 43:1-2*** (NKJV) - "But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you."

## **DAY 13 TOPIC: WHOLENESS**

***John 10:10*** (NKJV) – "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

***Jeremiah 30:17*** (NKJV) - "For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,' says the Lord, 'Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Zion; No one seeks her."

***Psalm 29:11*** (NKJV) – "The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace."

## **DAY 14 TOPIC: POWER**

***John 14:12*** (NKJV) – "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father."

***Matthew 10:1*** (NKJV) – "And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease."

**John 1:12** (NKJV) – “Then, six days before the Passover, Jesus came to Bethany, where Lazarus was who had been dead, whom He had raised from the dead.”

**2 Timothy 1:7** (NKJV) – “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

### **DAY 15 TOPIC: MONEY**

**Luke 6:38** (NKJV) – “Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

**Acts 20:35** (NKJV) – “I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive.’”

**Proverbs 11:24** (NKJV) – “There is one who scatters, yet increases more; And there is one who withholds more than is right, But it *leads* to poverty.”

**1 Timothy 6:10** (NKJV) – “For the love of money is a root of all *kinds of* evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.”

**Luke 12:15** (NKJV) - And He said to them, “Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.”

### **DAY 16 TOPIC: MARRIAGES**

**Genesis 2:24** (NKJV) – “Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be<sup>[a]</sup> joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.”

**Ephesians 5:25** (NKJV) – “Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her”

**Ephesians 5:22** (NKJV) – “Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.”

### **DAY 17 TOPIC: RELATIONSHIP**

**1 Peter 4:8** (NKJV) – “And above all things have fervent love for one another, for “love will cover a multitude of sins.”

**Ephesians 4:32** (NKJV) – “And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.”

**Colossians 3:13** (NKJV) – “bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*.”

### **DAY 18 TOPIC: REVELATION**

**2 Timothy 3:16-17** (NKJV) – “All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.”

**Psalm 119:130** (NKJV) – “The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple.”

**2 Peter 1:21** (NKJV) – “For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as *they* were moved by the Holy Spirit.”

## **DAY 19 TOPIC: PASTORS AND CHURCHES (pray for God's pastors and God's churches)**

**Acts 20:28** (NKJV) – “Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.”

**1 Peter 5:1-4** (NKJV) – “The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock; and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.”

**2 Timothy 4:2** (NKJV) – “Preach the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.”

## **DAY 20 TOPIC: HEALING**

**1 Peter 2:24** (NKJV) – “Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.”

**James 5:14-15** (NKJV) – “Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.”

**Jeremiah 17:14** (NKJV) – “Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved, For You are my praise.”

## **DAY 21 TOPIC: PRAYING FOR FIRST RESPONDERS, LAW ENFORCEMENT, MEDICAL PERSONNEL**

**Romans 13:3-4** (NKJV) – “For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same. For he is God’s minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God’s minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil.”

**Proverbs 21:15** (NKJV) – “*It is* a joy for the just to do justice, But destruction *will* come to the workers of iniquity.”

## **DAY 22 TOPIC: STRENGTH**

**Isaiah 41:10** (NKJV) – “Fear not, for I *am* with you; Be not dismayed, for I *am* your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”

**Philippians 4:13** (NKJV) – “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.”

**Psalm 46:1** (NKJV) – “God *is* our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.”

## **DAY 23 TOPIC: GUIDANCE**

**Psalm 32:8** (NKJV) – “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye.”

**Proverbs 3:5-6** (NKJV) – “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.”

**Proverbs 16:9** (NKJV) – “A man’s heart plans his way, But the Lord directs his steps.”

**Psalm 119:105** (NKJV) – “Your word *is* a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.”

## **DAY 24 TOPIC: HUMILITY**

***James 4:10*** (NKJV) – “Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

***Proverbs 29:23*** (NKJV) – “A man’s pride will bring him low, But the humble in spirit will retain honor.

***Proverbs 22:4*** (NKJV) – “By humility and the fear of the Lord Are riches and honor and life.

## **DAY 25 TOPIC: THOSE IN AUTHORITY**

***1 Timothy 2:2*** (NKJV) – “for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.”

***Proverbs 29:2*** (NKJV) – “When the righteous <sup>a</sup>are in authority, the people rejoice; But when a wicked *man* rules, the people groan.”

***Romans 13:1-4*** (NKJV) – “Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. <sup>2</sup> Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. <sup>3</sup> For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same. <sup>4</sup> For he is God’s minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God’s minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil.”

## **DAY 26 TOPIC: SINGLES**

***1 Corinthians 7:32-35*** (NKJV) – “But I want you to be without care. He who is unmarried cares for the things of the Lord—how he may please the Lord. <sup>33</sup> But he who is married cares about the things of the world—how he may please *his* wife. <sup>34</sup> There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world—how she may please *her* husband. <sup>35</sup> And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may serve the Lord without distraction.”

***Matthew 6:33*** (NKJV) – “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

## **DAY 27 TOPIC: WILLING MIND**

***Psalm 51:12*** (NKJV) – “Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit.”

***Romans 12:1*** (NKJV) – “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.”

***2 Corinthians 8:12*** (NKJV) – “For if there is first a willing mind, *it is* accepted according to what one has, *and* not according to what he does not have.”

## **DAY 28 TOPIC: MIRACLES, SIGNS, & WONDERS**

***Mark 16:17-18*** (NKJV) – “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; <sup>18</sup>they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

### **DAY 29 TOPIC: INCREASE**

***Proverbs 3:9-10*** (NKJV) – “Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; <sup>10</sup>So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.”

***Job 8:7*** (NKJV) – “Though your beginning was small, Yet your latter end would increase abundantly.”

***Joshua 1:8*** (NKJV) – “This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”

### **DAY 30 TOPIC: GENEROSITY**

***1 John 3:17*** (NKJV) – “But whoever has this world’s goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?”

***Galatians 6:2*** (NKJV) – “Bear one another’s burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.”

***Luke 6:38*** (NKJV) – “Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

***Hebrews 13:16*** (NKJV) – “But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.”

### **DAY 31 TOPIC: CONSECRATION**

***2 Corinthians 1:20*** (NKJV) – “For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.”

***Isaiah 43:26*** (NKJV) – “Put Me in remembrance; Let us contend together; State your case, that you may be acquitted.”
